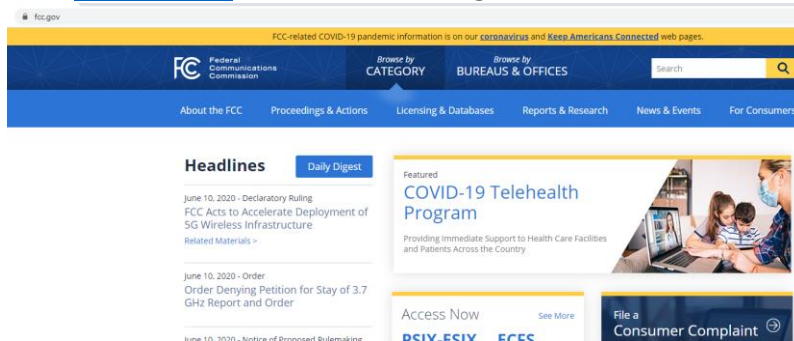


How to apply to the FCC for an amateur radio Vanity Call Sign

You will need your FRN (10 digit FCC Registration Number) and your Universal Licensing System password. It's the password you used when you applied for your FRN.

If you know your password but don't know your FRN:

Goto www.fcc.gov – hover on Licensing & Databases – click on Databases on the left menu



Scroll down to General Menu License Search – By Call Sign and click – Enter your Callsign and Submit Query – click on your Callsign

By checking this box, I certify that the call sign being requested was shown on the primary station license of my deceased spouse, child, grandchild, stepchild, parent, grandparent, stepparent, brother, sister, stepbrother, stepsister, aunt, uncle, niece, nephew, or in-law (in-law is defined as: parent, stepparent, sibling, or step-sibling of a licensee's spouse; and the spouse of a licensee's sibling, step-sibling, child or stepchild; or the spouse of a licensee's spouse's sibling or step-sibling) and that I can provide documentation, if requested.

Former primary station holder

By checking this box, I certify that the call sign being requested was previously assigned to my station and that I can provide documentation if requested.

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Enter up to 25 call signs in order of priority. Check to be sure they are available
