

APPLY FOR A GMRS (GENERAL MOBILE RADIO SERVICE) LICENSE

A GMRS license costs \$35.00 payable to the FCC (Federal Communications Commission). A single license is valid for 10 years and covers you and your family under the same license. The GMRS radio service is comprised of 22 channels in the UHF frequency spectrum. It is a licensed service but you simply pay the fee, there is no exam like in Ham or Amateur Radio Service.

First you will need to obtain an FRN (FCC Registration Number). This number will be used in lieu of your social security number throughout the FCC web site. Log into

CORES (COmission Registration System) – <https://apps.fcc.gov/cores/userLogin.do> - Need a Username? (create account and obtain FRN). Remember your Username, Password and FRN.

Once you have your FRN, log into the FCC ULS site to apply for the license.

ULS (Universal Licensing System)- <https://www.fcc.gov/wireless/universal-licensing-system> - File Online – (Username and Password required) – Apply for a New License (top of left yellow bar) – ZA = General Mobile Radio (GMRS) – Fill out application
